
Dr. Robert Cray - "Major John Andre – British Spy"

Dr. Robert E. Cray received his Ph.D. from Stony Brook University in 1984. Temple University Press published his dissertation, Paupers and Poor Relief

in New York City and its Rural Environs. 1700-1830, in 1988. Since that time, while teaching at Montclair State University, Cray has worked on social. religious, and maritime history. His work has appeared in the William & Mary Quarterly, the Journal of the Early Republic, Slavery & Abolition, The Historian, and other academic journals.
