

Biography – Amos Upham

Amos Upham was commissioned a Lieutenant by the Crown to serve as a military advisor in the town of Malden, MA in 1765.

Beginning on 20 April 1775, he served as a Patriot member of the Committee of Supply for the military company of Malden to procure and distribute supplies to those troops as they were called to service. In 1776, he was elected Selectman and Assessor, posts which he held in support of the military company of Malden through the end of the war to gain independence. He is buried in Wyoming Cemetery in Melrose, MA.
