

Here is the story of the 13 star flag.

My Great Grandmother (Grace Vernon Ferg - (1871 - 1964)) grew up in Media, PA and lived in Pennsauken NJ with her husband Frank Ferg and children including her Daughter Marie Ferg Baldwin - (1898 - 1986) and my Mother Ruth Baldwin Seabrook..

After my Great Grandmother died in 1964 my Grandmother Marie lived there until the early 1970s. My Mother, Father, and I had the job of cleaning out the house. Up in the attic I found a trunk with three American flags in including the one 13 star flag I brought to the July meeting of The Sons of the American Revolution. I also found a document stating that my Mother - Ruth Baldwin was in the D.A.R. Her ancestor was George W. Vernon my Great Grandmother's Great Grandfather. It looks like my Great-Great Grandfather (Dr. David Asbridge Vernon) got his middle name - Asbridge from his Father Rufus's Mother - Susana Asbridge's Father - David Asbridge who also fought in the Revolution.
